

The Bowling Green Township Comprehensive Plan Committee met Wednesday June 15, 2011 at 5:30PM in the Township Building.

Committee Chairperson Michael Pitcher called the meeting to order at 5:40PM.

Open action items were reviewed. The community building has been reserved for July 20th, 2011 7-9PM for presentation of the comprehensive plan surveys conducted in 2009. Advertisement statement to be reviewed by R. Edwards, finalized by M. Pitcher, and forwarded to the Fiscal officer for publication.

R. Edwards offered to present the survey results at the July hearing and the committee was in favor. Committee members will be present, however, to answer questions or to provide more detail during the presentation.

Examples of goals and mission statements were provided to all committee members by R. Edwards.

Much discussion was held regarding the major themes and issues discovered in the surveys. Committee members commented that different parts of the township disagree on the priorities. For example, while preserving the rural atmosphere was largely popular, there are differing opinions regarding the type of housing development to encourage. More examples were discussed.

Committee discussed the potential for water/sewer development and a township fire department.

A vision statement was discussed. R. Edwards to provide an initial draft statement for review during the next meeting.
